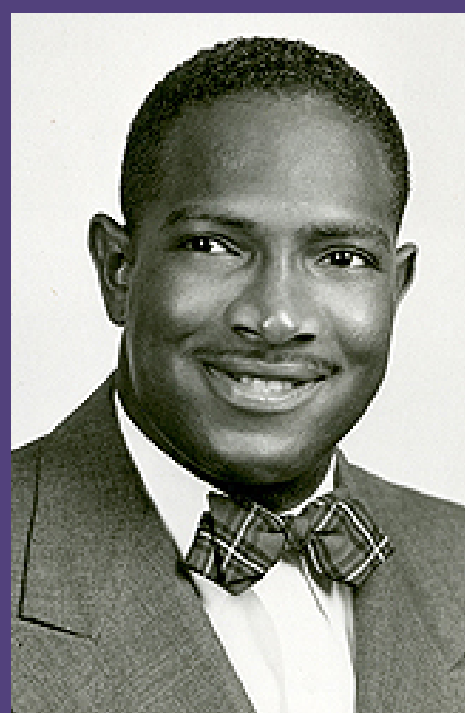

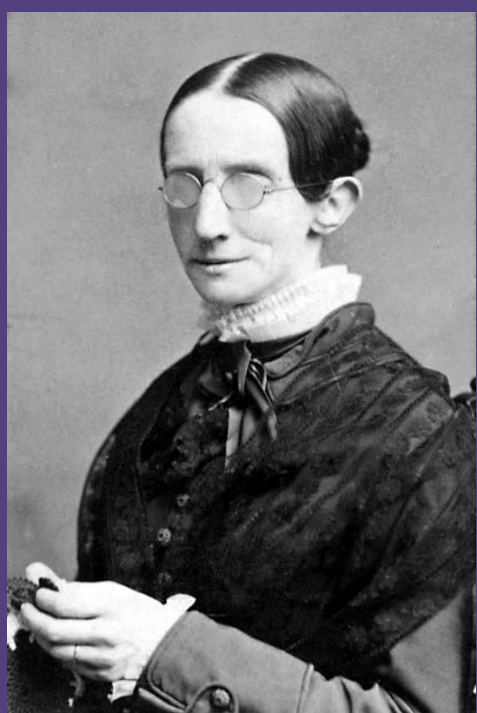


ANDREW FOSTER

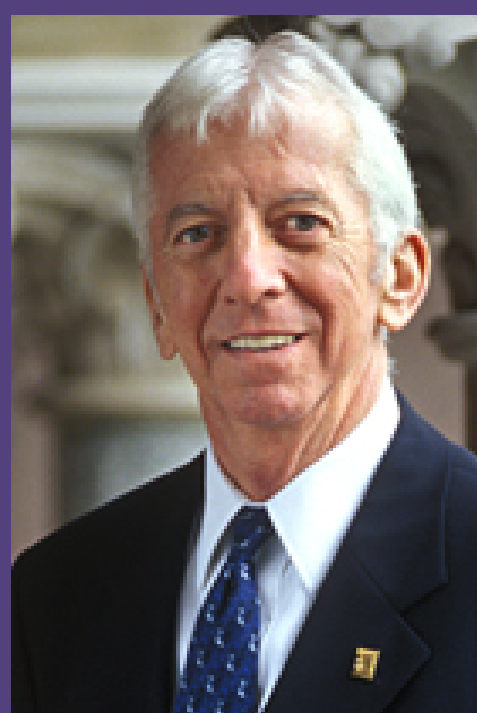


LAURA BRIDGMAN
